7. Other Agenda Items

7.1 Myuna Emergency Management System Consultation

- Under the NSW Work Health and Safety (Mines and Petroleum) Regulation 2014, Myuna is required consult with the community and local authority in preparation of its emergency plan.
- The Mine provided the information as contained in the attached presentation as part of this consultation.
- The CCC was informed that Myuna's Mine Manager and Compliance Manager have already consulted with police, local rescue organisations and Mines Rescue.
- RR asked if there had been communication with the community regarding the process in place should an event occur. PvR explained that Myuna have systems in place so that there should be minimal effect on the community and the purpose of consultation with the CCC was to communicate possible impacts and seek feedback. There has been no specific communication to the community about the emergency plan at this stage.
- GM commented about the potential links between Myuna's emergency plan and the Council's plan. PvR advised that some communication had been sent to the Council and face-to-face meeting had been organised to allow for consultation.
- GM asked about the protocol for first responders through SES and Council. RR commented that he assumed that Centennial would have an integrated multi-site approach to emergency management. PvR indicated Myuna has several Principal Hazard Management Plans (PHMP) as well as an Emergency Management Plan to manage the hazards as well as emergency situations, but the emergency services have their own procedures and protocols in place that will most likely prevail during emergency situations, should they get involved
