INGLENOOK EXPLORATION PROJECT

PROJECT UPDATE

Surface and ground water monitoring, meteorological data collection and flora surveys have been ongoing throughout 2015. This work involves:

- **Surface water and groundwater monitoring:** Verification of the results from the water census which was completed in 2010.
- **Autumn Flora Survey completed in March 2015:** The collection of data to understand species type and abundance. This information is collected as part of the projects baseline environmental data collection which allows Centennial to build a picture of what species are in the area and how the species behaves seasonally. This information will be used in future if the project is to progress through to an EIS stage.
- **Meteorological data:** The collection of temperature, wind direction and speed and rainfall.

Throughout 2015, no exploration drilling was undertaken which is a reflection on the current economic downturn in the mining sector. However, two additional land holder agreements have been negotiated.

ACTIVITIES PROPOSED FOR 2016

During 2016, monitoring and data collection activities will continue. These activities will include:

- Ongoing surface water and groundwater monitoring for baseline environmental data collection and hydrogeological modelling.
- Continued collection of meteorological data.
- A focus to secure drilling access agreements in anticipation that exploration drilling will resume early 2017.

STATUS OF EXPLORATION LICENCES

Applications for the renewal of EL7431, EL7432 and EL7442 have been submitted to Department of Resources and Energy.

The application process allows work to continue under the existing licence conditions until renewal has been granted and new licence conditions issued.

A decision on the applications for renewal is expected by July 2016.

COMMUNITY CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE

Community Consultative Committee (CCC) Meetings were held in 2015 on March 31, August 18 and November 24.

While there has been no exploration drilling, it is proposed to continue with the current meeting scheduling for 2016. This will allow for the ongoing update of our baseline data collection and interpretation of the results. The committee agreed at its March meeting to hold an extra ordinary meeting if any significant change was to occur to the project such as the resumption of exploration drilling on the project.

During the CCC meetings in 2015 Centennial provided an update of activities on the Inglebrook Exploration Project. Such activities include:

- Landholder Access Agreement negotiations.
- Ongoing environmental baseline monitoring.
- The committee also reviewed the operation and membership of the CCC. Each member confirmed their continuing representation on the CCC with the chair.

In July 2012 exploration drilling was completed in an area that was previously a quarry (formerly referred to as Mount Ilford Winery). This site has been rehabilitated and a meteorological station has been installed measuring temperature, wind direction and speed and rainfall.
